How Do You Understand Scripture?

(Caravan to Midnight #1)

Fred R. Coulter with John B. Wells-April 30, 2024

Moderator: Let me tell you about Mr. Fred Coulter. He brings to tonight's program a remarkable sixdecade ministry dedicated to preserving the Truth of God for future generations of faithful Christians. As a minister, an author and a publisher, Mr. Coulter has become a guardian of Biblical Truth against what he sees as the encroachment of secular, liberal, and 'new age' satanic influences *within religion*, *government, education, and economics!*

All aimed at safeguarding the true doctrines of Christ Jesus and the integrity of the Scriptures. We welcome him to Caravan to Midnight for the very first time. Mr. Fred Coulter. Good evening, sir.

FRED: Thank you, glad to be on!

<u>Moderator</u>: Now, do we address you as pastor or minister?

FRED: Well, I'll tell you this: There are so many highfalutin names and titles given to ministers that I follow what Paul did. I tell everyone this: If you can find in the New Testament *where Paul was called* 'Mr. Tarsus,' then you can call me Mr. Coulter. But otherwise, just call me *Fred*, just like everybody called Paul *Paul*!

Moderator: That sounds pretty good. That sounds pretty good. Well, let's get into it right away then. Fred, I appreciate your informal presentation here. So I'm thinking if you were to be asked about assessing the current state of 'Christianity' in today's world—especially in light of the recent cultural shifts, I read a story about it a while ago—a bunch out there in California has decided they want to protect people who want to buy children for sex and that will not be a felony, nor is giving AIDS to someone and not telling them; that's not a felony either.

I'm just wondering: How do you assess the current state of Christianity, while all this perversion and just general distortion just swirls around us like a tornado and right there in the eye of it or the hurricane? *Pick one!*

FRED: Well, that's a big one because that's everywhere. The world is filled with lies. And especially the most, how shall we say, important place that there needs to be Truth is belief in God. But too many want to come in with:

- their own ideas
- their own things
- their own thoughts

One of the things that is led to where we are today is the lawlessness that we see everywhere. *That lawlessness starts right in the pulpit, especially in Protestantism and Catholicism!* They twist and turn the Word of God, and have traditions and teachings and things that are contrary to the Scriptures and contrary to the Ten Commandments.

The thing that is so important is this: *No one* anywhere can get away from God even if you don't believe in Him because:

- you have to eat
- you have to sleep
- you have to have all of the things of life
- you need food
- you need water
- you need your body to run
- you need all of this to work

That's because God created it! But God has given free will agency, so we have to choose!

- What are we going to choose?
- What are we going to do?

And when it gets down to the ministers, and all of those who are false prophets, it's quite an amazing thing that comes up!

Let's look at a prophecy of this in Jer. 23. God is letting people go their way. But we'll see in just a little bit that *God is also judging*:

- every person
- every nation
- the whole world

Here it talks about what the ministers do. You can find this on TBN, Daystar, and in the Sunday pulpits; and you need to question about Sunday <u>because Sunday is not what God has</u> <u>commanded and Jesus never changed it</u>! That's been the whole story down through time.

Jeremiah 23:1: "<u>Woe to the shepherds</u> who destroy and scatter the sheep of My pasture,' says the LORD." *What do they do?* God says this:

Verse 15: "Therefore, thus says the LORD of hosts concerning the prophets, 'Behold, I will feed them wormwood, and make them drink poisonous water; for from the prophets of Jerusalem ungodliness has gone forth into all the land." That's expanded out to every pulpit in the whole world!

- they are preaching lies
- they're preaching licentiousness
- they're preaching lawlessness.

So, God says to us:

Verse 16: "Thus says the LORD of hosts, <u>'Do not listen to the words of the prophets who</u> <u>prophesy to you.</u> They make you vain; they speak a vision <u>from their own heart, not out of the mouth</u> <u>of the LORD</u>." Everyone who handles the Word of God:

- must do so in Truth
- must do so in righteousness

And when they speak, <u>they better speak the Truth of</u> <u>God</u>, because—when Jesus was under temptation with Satan the devil, the first thing He said—after the devil said to turn these stones into bread—"It is written..."

Even Jesus in His whole life, referred to the Word of God and was called it Himself 'Logos' in the Greek *meaning* Word. He said, "Man shall not live by bread alone, **but by every Word of God**." Now, stop and think.

There was no New Testament written. How are you going to live by every Word of God <u>*IF*</u> you say:

- the Old Testament is for the Jews only
- the Old Testament has been fulfilled
- that we don't need the Old Testament

And when you find that there are all kinds of prophecies that apply down through time and today, *even today!* So, God says, *don't listen to them!*

Verse 17: "'They still say to those who despise Me.' The LORD has said, 'You shall have peace!' And they say to <u>everyone who walks after</u> <u>the imagination of his own heart</u>, 'No evil shall come upon you!'"

That's a perfect description of what comes out of the pulpit every Sunday! You can look at the major ones:

- Kenneth Copeland
- Joel Osteen
- any one of them

and they have all of these false doctrines.

God went on to say, v 18: "For who has stood in the counsel of the LORD to see and hear His Word? Who has attended to His Word and heard *it*? Behold, the tempest of the LORD has gone forth in fury, a whirling tempest. It shall fall grievously upon the head of the wicked" (vs 18-19).

- they're not warning the wicked
- they're not backing up the righteous
- they're not backing up the Law enforcement

which God set in motion!

Today, just as Jesus said, <u>the land is filled</u> <u>with lawlessness!</u> Now notice what God says concerning them."

Verse 21: "'<u>I have not sent these prophets</u>, yet, they ran; <u>I have not spoken to them</u>, yet, they prophesied. But <u>IF</u> they had stood in My counsel and had caused My people to hear My words, <u>THEN</u> they would have turned them from their evil way and from the evil of their doings" (vs 21-22). Just like I said at the beginning:

- no one can get away from God
- no one can get away from the Word of God

It is going to be a blessing <u>or</u> it's going to be the punishment for sin. So, God says here:

Verse 25: "'I have heard what the prophets said, who prophesy lies in My name, saying, 'I have dreamed, I have dreamed.'"

Verse 27: "<u>They scheme to cause My</u> <u>people to forget My name</u> by their dreams, which they tell, each one to his neighbor, as their fathers have forgotten My name for Baal. The prophet who has a dream, let him tell a dream<u>. And he who has</u>

My Word, <u>let him speak My Word faithfully</u>" (vs 27-28)—*honestly all the time!*

Verse 29: "'*Is* not My Word like a fire?' says the LORD, 'and like a hammer *that* breaks the rock in pieces? Therefore, behold, <u>I am against the prophets who steal My words</u> each one from his neighbor. Behold, I am against the prophets who use their tongues and say, "He says," when I did not say. (vs 29-31).

He says this concerning those who have the Word of God:

"...<u>And he who has My Word</u>, <u>let him</u> <u>speak My Word faithfully....</u>" (v 28).

So that's about as quick a summary as you can get. There are plenty of other verses too, and the whole society is running, running contrary to the Word of God, contrary to everything, *and coming into the depths of satanism*.

I'll just tell you one thing that's very, very important to understand. You see all these archeological diggings that they're doing and they're seeking: What did these people do in:

- Egypt?
- Southeast Asia?
- China?
- India?
- The Mayan Peninsula?

Why do all those societies and nations and empires end up destroyed? *Because when they get so corrupt, they openly worship Satan the devil!*

When that happens you have human sacrifice! When that happens, you have the curses of God brought upon them, and those nations and those empires come to nothing!

- How far along are we in Satan worship?
- Do we not have satanic temples available?
- Do we not have things that are absolutely abominable?

What is the greatest sin and problem in America, and yes, in the world today? *Many people don't know!* They want it as a legal right, *and that is the sin of abortion!*

<u>Abortion is murder</u> and there is no reproduction if everything is aborted. So, all of that is the way of death. God has the punishment coming upon us right now *because of abortion!* Many people don't believe it and they don't understand it. The politicians don't have a clue!

If you go to Deut. 28, you see all the blessings that come <u>for keeping the</u> <u>Commandments of God!</u> Now, God gave the Ten

Commandments as a blessing so we could all have contact with Him, that we could worship Him and *no other gods!* That we could have stable families, that we could have no murder, no adultery, no thievery, all of this sort of thing. <u>That's what the</u> <u>Ten commandments are.</u> I gave a whole segment on Church at Home {churchathome.org} about Perfectville, that everyone wants to live in Perfectville where there is no crime, yet they don't want to keep the Commandments of God.

So, here we are. Everyone thought, especially Jonathan Cahn... Now he's very intelligent, knows quite a few things, but he's not a prophet and he doesn't represent Christ *because he's still a rabbi!*

But they don't know what God does in the punishment. So I subscribe to everyone: Read the whole chapter 28 of the book of Deuteronomy. This applies to all the descendants of the 12 tribes of Israel, and every nation that goes against the Word of God.

There are blessings if you love God and keep His Commandments. There are punishments that come, and here is what God said, and we see it today. It's called *the immigration problem*.

That problem is based almost solely on *the* 62 million-plus abortions that have been performed in the United States of America, the country that says that we founded our Constitution on God, and we have *In God We Trust* on our money, and we say that we're a Christian nation! But we're **anything but** a Christian nation!

When we get so far off the track and have this great innocent blood hanging on everyone, every politician, every minister, every woman and man who agrees with abortion. So, here is what God has said would happen, and it's happening right now, and they don't know why it's happening. They blame Biden. Well, Biden is there as punishment for us because we've turned our backs on God.

So let me read what God says very plainly in Deut. 28:43, because as Jesus said, 'God's Word is always working and in the nations and individuals and families' and so forth.

Deuteronomy 28:43: "<u>The stranger</u> <u>dwelling among you shall get up above you very</u> <u>high, and you shall come down very low</u>." Is that not what is happening?

Moderator: Seems so, yes!

FRED: You have to be careful. Look at even the riots that are happening with the students today in the colleges.

Now, here's another part of it. We have economic problems because of the dollar losing value.

Verse 44: "He shall loan to you, and you shall not loan to him. He shall be the head, and you shall be the tail."

All right. Is that happening? Do we not have warnings today that the dollar is being devalued? They don't know what to do. We just had it heard an ad on your program here about what people need to do because of inflation. All right. Now then, here's the reason.

Verse 45: "And all these curses shall come on you, and shall pursue you and overtake you, until you are destroyed, because you did not obey the voice of the LORD your God..."

Isn't that what Jesus said? 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God.'

"...you did not obey the voice of the LORD your God to keep His commandments and His statutes, which He commanded you. And they shall be on you for a sign..." (vs 45-46)—*this is all the 12 tribes of Israel!*

Now we've got a book we'll send to you <u>free</u>; it is entitled *America and Britain: Their Biblical Origin and Their Prophetic Destiny.* Now listen carefully to this:

Verse 46: "And they shall be on you <u>for a</u> <u>sign and for a wonder</u>, and on your seed <u>forever</u>." *Nothing's done away!*

Verse 47: "<u>Because you did not serve the</u> <u>LORD your God</u> with joyfulness and with gladness of heart for the abundance of all *things*, therefore, you shall serve your enemies, which the LORD shall send against you..." (vs 47-48).

That's what we see happening right now. The storm is gathering and unless there's some real good repentance. and it's got to start with everyone, it's got to start beginning with the churches. The first thing the churches need to renounce is *Sundaykeeping, idolatry, and holiday-keeping!*

Moderator: That's interesting!

Moderator: That's excellent! We're going to take our top of the hour break now. Minister Fred Coulter, just call him Fred he says, but what is a minister? *A minister is someone who gets things done!* You got me? That's what a minister is. Just depends on the nature of the ministry. In this case, Fred Coulter is all about the ministry of God's Word. When we come back, we're going to talk about *A Faithful Version*. Which Bible should we really be reading?

Guess what the center and who is the center of all energy? Yeah, so it's true. Energy equals genius. As we visit with Fred Coulter, the true face of ancient words.

Fred, I want to save the heavy stuff a little bit later on, but I would like for you to tell us about this is really quite amazing: **afaithfulversion.org**.

You and your researchers and all... Look, people are so confused because they don't know really well the King's James Bible, King James didn't really want to write it, but 'blah, blah, 'Some people say King James hadn't written that Bible we'd have a lot fewer problems now. Set that aside.

Then we have the *Amplified*. We have the *New English Standard*. We have... <u>What is the correct Bible we should be reading?</u> Some have said the *Septuagint* Bible. I was told that this is the Bible that the disciples studied. I don't know, but I'm pretty sure you do.

Could you tell us which Bible should we be studying and what about *especially your faithful translation* of Scripture?

FRED: Well, thanks for answering. That's a long question to answer, but I'll do the best that I can. First of all, my first publication was *A Harmony of the Gospels*, and that's Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. Most people don't have a clue concerning this:

The Bible calendar is not the Roman calendar hanging on the wall in your house. It is the Calculated Hebrew Calendar. Everything in the Old Testament and New Testament is based on that calendar; likewise, that means the Sabbath and the Holy Days and the things that God has commanded.

Now then, the reason that I did *A Harmony* of the Gospels was because there was so much confusion in the Church I was in at that time and so much politics--this was back in 1972 and 73—that

the best thing to do when there's trouble and difficulty is *keep your mind on Christ and keep your mind on the Word of God*, because that will always remain true.

Well, they became so corrupt that I had to resign in 1979, and subsequently ended up founding the Christian Biblical Church of God in 1983. And then we were a small group and we had a small number of people, and so I just taught them out of the Bible, and we progressed with it.

What I did is an in-depth study because I've studied the Greek now for about 40 years. I did an in-depth study in the General Epistles, which is James, 1st & 2nd Peter, 1st, 2nd & 3rd John, and Jude. Then when I got done with that, someone sent me from England the first transgender Bible.

Moderator: Oh, no!

FRED: Yes! And they said, concerning the name of God the Father, that that was just a metaphor.

Moderator: Oh, gotcha!

FRED: Yeah! And I stood there in my library reading that, and they said this: 'Because it is a metaphor, we're translating it Father/Mother,' *which is a complete, absolute desecration and violation of the Word of God,* and the purpose of translating.

So, I was updating for *A Harmony of the Gospels* with what became the *Faithful Version*. Right at that point, I said to myself, <u>*IF*</u> we don't answer this, <u>*THEN*</u> God is going to hold us responsible. Because:

- *IF* we're dealing with the Word of God
- \overline{IF} we're not faithful with the Word of God
- \overline{IF} we don't teach it properly

God is going to judge us most severely!

So, then I said at that point that I've got to do the New Testament. First of all, we did that, translated it from the Greek. I did all the translating, wrote commentaries and appendices to go with it, and we published that in 2005.

Then Michael Heiss, who is a converted Jew joined with us, and he grew up in a Jewish family. He knew Yiddish, and he knew Hebrew, and went to the Hebrew Union College and also to Judeo College there in Los Angeles. So, he did the translating of the Old Testament, because there were so many errors, because people want to put <u>their</u> <u>ideas</u> into the Bible, <u>rather than take the Bible as the inspired Word of God</u>!

So that's how it started out, and that's how we have the Bible. So now it is a unique Bible

translated in English, because it has all the books of the Bible—Old Testament and New Testament—in their original manuscript order.

Moderator: It's amazing! You know what I'm saying? Okay, as we carry on now for the remainder of the program and the majority of the hour with Fred Coulter. So, this is *A Faithful Version*. How long did it take to complete, Fred? *Seems like an absolutely monumental task, but it's been done!*

FRED: Actually, it took the better part of 20 years in doing it and putting it together for the New Testament, and Michael Heiss had been doing that privately for years himself. We went to college together at Ambassador College in Pasadena, and he also had to resign because of the corruption that was there.

We just have to, like I mentioned there, that it says in Jeremiah 23, **"The one who has my word, let him speak my word faithfully."** And that means we have *to know and prove and understand* that the Word of God is inspired of God. The Old Testament is in Hebrew and the New Testament is in Greek.

Now to answer your question on the Septuagint. The Septuagint was translated into Greek and is a fairly good translation overall. But the one that God selected to preserve the, what we call the Old Testament was the Jews and also the Hebrew Sacred Calendar.

What we have with this in translating that is to translate *every word as closely as possible to the original language!*

Now we just finished a mammoth work that took us seven years, and that is a *Greek-English Interlinear*. That is unique, too, because it's the only Interlinear that has all the Greek letters in large bold, and it's a big thick heavy book. And of course, most people just like to flick their finger on a keyboard today.

So anyway, we have that. Back to the Bible. The whole Bible has *seven divisions*, and all the books have to be in the original manuscript order. So you have:

- 1. The Law
- 2. The **Prophets**
- 3. The Writings

That's the Old Testament. That's what Jesus taught the disciples in Luke 24 when he appeared to them after his resurrection. Then we have the New Testament, which contains:

- 4. The Gospels:
 - Matthew
 - Mark

- Luke
- John
- Acts

That's the fourth division! The fifth division is:

- 5. <u>The General Epistles</u>
 - James
 - 1st, 2nd Peter
 - 1st, 2nd, 3rd John
 - Jude
- 6. Epistles of Paul (all 14)
- 7. Book of Revelation

Now, <u>when</u> all of this is restored, <u>then</u> the <u>purposeful design of the Scriptures</u> really begin to become clear and begin to reveal God's inspiration! We do this because we know that God's Spirit will cause us to do what is right <u>IF we love God and keep His Commandments and hold God's Word as the absolute Truth!</u>

That's what Paul wrote, 2-Timothy 3:16 "All Scripture....[that means Old Testament and New Testament] ...is God-breathed."

Now, God-breathed actually means *God-spirited*, because <u>when</u> people read the Bible and they get that in their mind and they believe it:

- *then* they have to obey it
- *then* they have to come to love God

<u>When</u> they do, they will understand the Word of God, and it is magnificent! It is the only book in the world that tells you:

- why we're here
- where we're going
- what God has done
- what He's going to do in the future
- when Christ is coming back again
- how He is coming back again
- what is going to happen

All of those things are contained in the New and the Old Testament together.

So, when people say the Old Testament has been fulfilled, *they miss all of the Scriptures that have to do with his second coming!*

In a review that we had of the New Testament by Dan Decker, he said:

"It is an excellent translation for those desiring a literal one!"

Now let me just give you an example of something that is completely misunderstood by those in Protestantism and Catholicism. And really, unfortunately, for those who are good Catholics and so forth, they don't realize how many things that are just the tradition of men that they're doing <u>and</u> <u>they're not from the Bible</u>!

But nevertheless, you see, the Word of God is absolutely true. Jesus said, "Your Word is the Truth."

<u>IF</u> it's the Truth and we're told to prove all things, <u>THEN</u> we need to prove all things to make sure that we have it right!

That's what we've done with the *Faithful Version*. We have with it commentaries and appendices; we have in there:

<u>When was Jesus Born</u>? Everyone wants to know when He was born. Hello! <u>NOT</u> on the 25th of December! Everyone wants to know when was He raised from the dead! <u>It wasn't on Easter Sunday!</u> How long was he in the tomb? Three full days and three full nights, just like He said.

And all that's in *A Harmony of the Gospels* that we have and also in the Bible.

So it is really a tremendous *study Bible for people to really know and understand the Word of God!* Now then, we sent you one by priority mail, so you would have it to show your viewers. But unfortunately...

Moderator: No, they're listeners.

FRED: ...it didn't arrive.

<u>Moderator</u>: No, it didn't. I suspect that's by demonic design, but maybe I'm just reaching here, but it wouldn't surprise me at all.

FRED: So, I'm going to send you by UPS next day air: I'm going to send you a Bible, going to send you those books. And I've got a beautiful picture of the temple, what the temple looked like in Jesus' day. Where the Jews want to build the temple today, where the Mosque of Omar is, never happen! *Never happen!* That's the whole fight going on, but maybe I can bring that at another time when you have the picture to show everyone and I can explain it.

Moderator: Well, I can't because we're over the air radio, but I could certainly do it during the video prologue. I could certainly do some of that and even make a longer one if I wanted to.

FRED: Okay!

Moderator: Let's use probably an inappropriate term, but let's rock and roll it and get as much into this conversation as we can. This concept of a new temple is not explicitly mentioned in the Bible. The Bible does speak about it, right? Take it away.

FRED: Oh, it is! See, when we get back from the break, we'll talk about *How Do You Understand Scripture*?

Because that's the important thing. We have our minds in sequential events that when we read it, one thing follows another in time sequence, but that's not always true. And that's how God has designed the Bible. A little here, a little there, a little at another place, *and you put it together and then you get the whole picture!* And I'll give you a couple examples of that.

Moderator: Okay. Go right ahead. We have a few minutes here. I was just giving you a heads up, but no, we're not just on the verge of a break. So carry on as you wish.

FRED: Let me give you an example right here of prophecy fulfilled. Let's come to the book of Daniel, chapter 12. That's a very interesting book because everything comes from Daniel. Now it talks about the end-time. He said here

Daniel 12:4: "But you, O Daniel, <u>shut up</u> <u>the words and seal the book, even to the time of</u> <u>the end</u>. Many shall <u>run to and fro</u>..."

Now think about it today. Think about how this one phrase many <u>run to and fro</u> is literally fulfilled around the world. People are going everywhere on every kind of transportation, whether it's, it's by roller skate, skateboard, bicycle, motorcycle, car, bus, truck, plane, boat, whatever. Everybody's going everywhere. So, that's just one phrase of prophecy and look at the magnitude of its fulfillment.

The next phrase is "...and <u>knowledge shall</u> <u>be increased</u>" (v 4).

Moderator: Internet!

FRED: What do we have today? We have knowledge increased so much that they have A.I., and A.I. is going to be the bane of everything because it's the collection of all the writings of men.

- it has no soul
- it has no mind
- it has no feeling
- it has no emotions
- it cannot make judgments of morality

That's what's going to trap the whole world! A.I. is going to be the death knell of freedom of speech and freedom of person, because they will know:

• who you are

- where you are
- what you are doing

And that gets into the *Mark of the Beast* in Rev. 13. *That is coming! We're getting closer and closer and closer to it!*

You probably have some of your ads with some of those financial people that are talking about gold and silver and so forth and the digital money that the banks want to have.

The banks and the Bible talks about Satan and his merchandising and he's the one behind the whole banking system today. Actually the Bible says that *Satan is deceiving the whole world!* This is why we have all the troubles that we have because people are not going to the Word of God to follow it so they won't be misled by the satanic things that are going on in the world.

So, that's going to come and it's going to close everything down. It's going to be just like these riots going on in the universities and colleges now. If you don't agree with them, you're going to be killed. And that's the end-time martyrdom of the saints, which will be coming because:

- they *will not* take the *mark of the beast*
- they *will not* bow down and worship the beast
- they *will not* turn their back on God

but

- *they will keep* the Word of God and the faith of Jesus Christ
- *they will be killed* just like they were in the Dark and Middle Ages over in Europe

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Moderator: Well, this is really fantastic. And, you know, we're going to have to speak together several times. I predict that this is going to happen because we absolutely have to. There are so many things that we wish we could get into tonight, including the Talmud and the practitioners, the ones who are the ones who are leaning on the entire world right now and have well for over 2,000 years.

In addition, once the original order of the 49 Biblical books has been restored, the seven divisions of the Bible are also re-established. The Old Testament contains the Law, the Prophets and the Writings. *Fred told us that*.

The New Testament contains the Gospels and Acts, the General Epistles, the Epistles of Paul, and the book of Revelation. With this restoration, God's purposeful design of the Scriptures begins to unfold, revealing His Divine inspiration. As the Apostle Paul wrote, *all Scripture is God-breathed* and thus reflects the mind of Almighty God, Creator of heaven and earth.

Moderator: WOW! This is really amazing, Fred, what a masterpiece of work. It's just amazing! Do we have time to... Now, I think perhaps you and I should talk over the phone and decide how we're going to approach this. But how are we supposed to view the Talmud readers and the liars who claim, who call themselves Jews, but who are not.

And this piece of real estate, which is a registered, corporation in the city of London, called the State of Israel. How are we to view this tumult going on between the Palestinians and the State of Israel, which has now morphed into this campus unrest? I'm sensing color revolution here, but we don't have to get into that. How should we view this conflict?

FRED: Well, I tell you what. First of all, to answer your question concerning the Babylonian Talmud. That is one of the most evil satanic books in the world, especially when it gets to sexual perversion and promiscuity and pedophilia. And the rabbis have turned their backs on the Bible, the Old Testament, for *their traditions*.

Now, it's just like the Christians in the New Testament. They say they follow the New Testament, but they don't. *They follow their own traditions!*

Now, getting to the situation with Jerusalem, that is Biblically true that there will be Jews there. Now, intermixed with the Jews are the Khazarian Jews, *who are not* actually the genetic Jews from the tribe of Judah, one of the 12 tribes of Israel. Those who are genetically Jews and genetically Levites and priests, they've been pretty well able to analyze on a chromosomal level, so they know the few who are real.

Now, the Bible does show—and I can take that as a separate program in the future—that there will be a third temple. That third temple will be built. It will be called the Temple of God, <u>but God</u> <u>will not be there</u>, because we have access directly to God in heaven above. God is as close to us as our knees are to the floor when we pray with:

- sincerity and truth to God
- confessing our sins
- praising God
- understanding His Word
- living by every Word of God

as Jesus has said!

That's not going to happen with the temple. The ashes of the heifers that they're going to sacrifice won't clean anybody. That's why Christ came to elevate the worship of God from temple service and sacrifices to *direct with God*, <u>directly to</u> <u>God the Father and Jesus Christ</u> through prayer and through study!

That is a lifetime, whole proposition of what needs to be done. That is why we have the New Testament.

We also have a book called *The Apostle Paul's Teachings on God's Laws*, which covers all the difficult Scriptures that the Protestants use and misinterpret to say that they can do what they want to do, or the Catholics do what they want to do.

But, you know, all of those who are good Catholics, you have to ask this:

You get your catechism and you read the Ten Commandments. Then you get your Bible, the Douay Version of the Bible, and you read Exo. 20 with the Ten Commandments. And lo and behold, you will find this. In the Ten Commandments, in Exodus, the Second Commandment is in the Scriptures. But in the catechism, they remove the Second Commandment, which says, "You shall not make anything of any likeness in heaven above on the earth, beneath or under the earth, or in the waters that are under the earth. And you shall not bow yourself down to them or worship them or serve them."

That is removed from the catechism. So. what do we see in the Catholic Church? Statues, images...

Moderator: Graven images!

FRED: ... crucifixes! All of that, that is not in the Bible, and that's not how to worship God. You worship God by praying directly to Him as Jesus said, and not just mimic the prayer. The prayer to God is, "Our Father Who is in heaven, Holy is Your name! And Christ at Your right hand is our Savior." Then you ask God, "Your will be done!"

How many people ask that every day? The will of God be done as it is in heaven on earth! Now, when it's on earth, that's referring to each one of us. What is the will of God? Well, the will of God is in His Word, and the Word has everything there that we need!

The New Testament combined with the Old Testament is the most fantastic book in the world. *It comes from God, and it's translated in 3,000 different languages, so that everybody can know!*

We've got groups in Algeria, South Africa, Kenya, Philippines, Malaysia, Canada, Central America, all through the United States. Not a lot of people, but dedicated, sincere, and true followers of God.

Now, getting back to the temple that is going to be built. You can go online what is called *The Temple Institute* {templeinstitute.org} and spend some time on it, and you will see that they have developed all the things for the priest to wear, all of the utensils that they need to have, everything like that. It is all ready to go, and they've got the plans, and the things that they need.

God has *kept them from understanding* where it needs to be built, because if they knew, they would have built it already. But where the Mosque of Omar is, *that's not where the temple was!* That was Fort Antonia, and when you get the picture of it, you'll see it.

There were 5,000 Roman troops there, and 5,000 support personnel that lived there. It was a virtual city, 38 acres, a big place. <u>The temple was to</u> <u>the south of it</u>!

Now, when you go to the Temple Institute, they'll have on there the Levitical singers singing looking toward the south of Fort Antonia; that's where the temple will be built. When the temple is starting to being built, you know the time and the return of Christ is coming soon. *And that's another whole thing!* I could do a whole program on the return of Christ.

Moderator: I look forward to it.

FRED: Let me just tell you how God put the Bible together and why it's difficult for people to

understand, because they don't know how to separate it out. One of the major keys is this: <u>It is</u> <u>based on the Sabbath and the Holy Days!</u> Keeping those brings knowledge and understanding as to what God is going to do, because every major event that God does in the world is noted by all the Holy Days of God!

But people can't understand the Bible because they pick it up and they read it like an ordinary book, *when they need to treat it like it has come from God!*

Let me give you a quick demonstration on how the Old Testament has been put together and likewise part of the New Testament, *because it's not all in chronological order*. I'll explain that in a little bit. But here's what God says.

Isaiah 28:9: "Whom shall He teach knowledge? And whom shall He make to understand doctrine? *Those* who are weaned from the milk and drawn from the breasts."

In other words, you can't be a brand new newbie and understand the Bible. You have to have some experience and knowledge in doing it, and here's how He put it together.

Verse 10: "For precept *must be* upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, there a little."

So, there are places in the Bible that jump ahead in time. Now, let me show you one of Jesus Christ here in Isa. 50, which is really very interesting, because we find in the Gospel of John, chapter seven, that they were wondering how Jesus learned what He did, because He didn't go to any of the rabbis' schools. Now think about this: If he had gone to one of those rabbis' schools, they would have killed that rabbi.

Isaiah 50:4—*it says this of a prophecy of Christ:* "The Lord GOD has given Me [Christ] the tongue of the learned..."

Now that's speaking of Christ And when He was 12 years old, He talked to all the priest at the temple and they were amazed what he knew.

"...to know to help the weary *with* a word. <u>He awakens *Me* morning by morning</u>, <u>He</u> <u>awakens My ear to hear as one being taught</u>" (v 4).

God the Father taught Jesus Christ right from the beginning during His entire life up until He began His ministry when He was 30-years-old.

Verse 5: "The Lord GOD has opened My ear, and I was not rebellious, nor turned away backwards."

That talking about Christ and his infancy and growing up, *the very next verse*:

Verse 6: "I gave My back to the smiters, and My cheeks to them that plucked off the hair; I did not hide My face from shame and spitting."

That's the day of His crucifixion. So it's not in chronological order. It doesn't tell you anything other than how Jesus was taught. Doesn't tell you anything about his ministry; that's found in other places, because here's a little, there's a little, and it has to be *rightly divided* as the Apostle Paul wrote in 2-Tim. 2. Rightly divided means you take the precept here, you take the Word there and you put it together, then you have a whole picture of what God is doing!

Now let's do one more and that's in Isa. 9; it talks about Jesus. I asked Michael Heiss, "How do the Jews understand this in Isa. 9:6? He told me, "Well, they don't know what to make of it." It talks about Jesus' birth, and that connects also with Isa. 50, how He was taught. But listen to this:

Isaiah 9:6: "For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; and the government shall be upon His shoulders; and His name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The Mighty God, The Everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. Of the increase of *His* government and peace *there shall be* no end, upon the throne of David, and over His Kingdom, to order it and to establish it with judgment and with righteousness from henceforth, even forever. <u>The zeal of the LORD of hosts will</u> <u>do this</u>" (vs 6-7).

Now the Jews can't understand it because, how can someone be born and be God? They reject the New Testament and all it tells us in the first chapter of Luke about how John the Baptist came into being and how Jesus came into being.

A Child is born; government shall be upon His shoulders. When is the government going to be upon Jesus' shoulders? *When He comes as King of kings and Lord of lords*!

In the meantime, He's the Head of the Church, and He's the One Who governs the Church through His Spirit and through His Word,"...<u>and</u> <u>His name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor,</u> <u>The Mighty God</u>..."

And that's what we find, He is the Mighty God. There are \underline{two} in the Godhead, the Father and Christ the Son.

In the Old Testament, They were called *the Most High* and *the Lord God!* Now then, it says:

"...<u>The Everlasting Father</u>..." (v 6). How can that be?

Well, they don't understand that the New Testament Church is to be the Bride of Christ. *When they're all resurrected with Christ and come back to the earth to rule the earth!* They will rule the earth and all of those who were saved at that time will be the result of what Jesus and the Church is doing. So, He becomes an "Everlasting Father" beginning at that time.

It has nothing to do with God the Father here in Isa.9:6. "...the Prince of Peace."

That's a good example of how you need other parts of the Bible properly put together to understand some of these Scriptures. Now we can do that when I have an opportunity to bring something on the temple, and then we can get into:

- How is Christ going to return?
- How is every eye going to see Him?

We all ought to know that *the rapture is not true! It's a figment of the imagination of men* who confuse the resurrection and confuse a small group of people that are saved from the Tribulation. There's a lot! *The Bible contains so much, it is absolutely incredible!*

People don't know it because they're not taught it. And you can't learn it in any of the colleges or seminaries or things like that. You can learn so much, that is true. But it comes:

- by study
- by prayer
- by living it
- by doing it
- by preaching it
- by writing it

It just doesn't all of a sudden happen and here we've done these things. No, I've done a lot of writing. As a matter of fact, I've written 15 books, and those transcript books are actually studies with sermons that I have done, and the audio CDs come with them. We've got a whole one. It's a big thick study on Daniel and Revelation because those two go together. You can't have one without the other.

Now, let me show you another oddity that most people don't even understand or realize. That's also found in the book of Daniel, the fourth chapter. Now, before we get there, let's come to:

Dan. 2:20_[transcriber's correction]—when the dream that King Nebuchadnezzar had was revealed to Daniel. He thanked God:

Daniel 2:20: "Daniel answered and said, 'Blessed be the name of God forever and ever, for wisdom and might are His. And He changes the times and the seasons; He removes kings and sets up kings. He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to those who have understanding. He reveals the deep and secret things..." (vs 20-22).

Let's look at Dan. 4, which is quite an interesting thing because of who wrote it.

Daniel 4:1: "Nebuchadnezzar the king, to all people, nations, and languages, that dwell in all the earth: 'Peace be multiplied to you. It seemed good to me to declare the signs and wonders that the Most High God has done for me. How great *are* His signs! And how mighty *are* His wonders! His Kingdom *is* an everlasting Kingdom, and His dominion *is* from generation to generation' (vs 1-3).

King Nebuchadnezzar of ancient Babylon wrote Dan. 3

Moderator: Unbelievable! Amazing! There's so much, there is so much more that we don't know in these rumors that these red heifers are genetically engineered. Let's say they are for the moment.

Then you have artificial intelligence. Then you have melding humans with machines and neural links and so forth!

Ladies and gentlemen, what do we think is going on? Now remember what Fred Coulter said, Special #1 {https://www.cbcg.org/caravan.html}

Fred Coulter, what a delight to speak with you tonight. We're out of time for the program this evening, but I invite you to come back on much, much sooner than later. I really mean that. Thank you so much for your time and this enlightening dissertation tonight. Thank you for being here with us!

FRED: Thank you! Bye!

Moderator: All right. Short and sweet. Wow, was that powerful or what? This is not over; not by a long shot! Matter of fact, it's just my opinion, but I think it's just starting. God bless you, everyone!
